- (Luke 13:6-9) The Gospels often refer to our lives “bearing fruit” as result of doing God’s will and living according to God’s Kingdom. In what ways does your life “bear fruit” by being a follower of Jesus Christ?

- (Luke 14:15-24) Who are you in this Parable of the Banquet and why?

- Of all the parables found in Luke 13-18, which is your favorite one and why?

Which parable(s) do you find most challenging or confusing? Why?

- (Luke 18:35-43) Jesus asks the blind man, “What do you want me to do for you?” If Jesus came to you and asked you the very same question, what would your answer be?

(Luke 13-18) Jesus talks about the “Kingdom of God” 14 different times in these five chapters alone and discusses the “Kingdom of God” more than any other topic.

Based on your reading and in your own words, how would you describe “The Kingdom of God?”
